## **MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS**

Clothing for all drivers at this event includes: a Snell SA 2010 or 2015 Helmet, long sleeve shirt, long pants, socks, all made of non-synthetic materials, and closed toe shoes. Recommended but not mandatory are: driver's suit, driving gloves, driver shoes and a protective neck brace all made of Nomex or similar fire-resistant material, and a properly mounted fire extinguisher. You will be required to show a valid driver's license along with a valid PCA Membership card at registration. If you or your car does not pass Tech Inspection, you will not be able to drive. You can save time at the track by bringing your car to a recognized Porsche Dealer or Porsche Specialty Shop for mechanical inspection and having them complete, sign and stamp the Chicago Region Tech Inspection Sheet. Pay particular attention to specifics concerning brake pads and fluid, since Blackhawk Farms is very hard on the brake system!

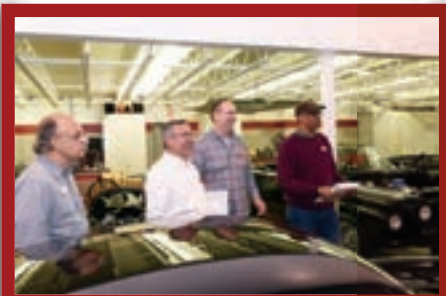

# FINE CAR CARE

Number 4

## Stone Chips

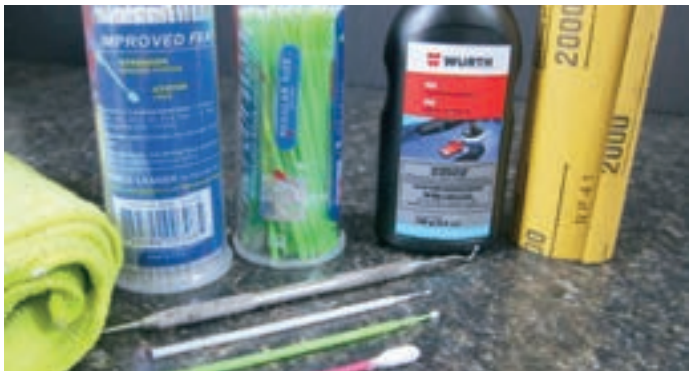
This is one of the biggest irritants that we have with our beautiful Porsches – stone chips. There are various products and systems on the market but you must be prepared to take time and have patience. You will be rewarded with a finish that is almost as new. You will do things that may seem to be damaging your beautiful paint but take heart, it does work. Like any skill or art it requires practice and there are options for you as well. When I first started I bought an old Porsche door at a junk yard and used that as my test bed. If this doesn't interest you then move to option 2 – test on your wife's car. I cleaned, filled chips, sanded, polished and waxed using different products until I got the results I wanted. It was a journey to learn the techniques as well as which tools to use.



Small short dabs of paint work best

## Sources of Paint

Porsche dealers sell touch-up tubes but you can also buy from online sources that have a wide range of colors for all years and models. The one that I have had the most consistent best quality is AutomotiveTouchup at [www.automotivetouchup.com](http://www.automotivetouchup.com). Don't use the brush that is attached to the top with any paint.

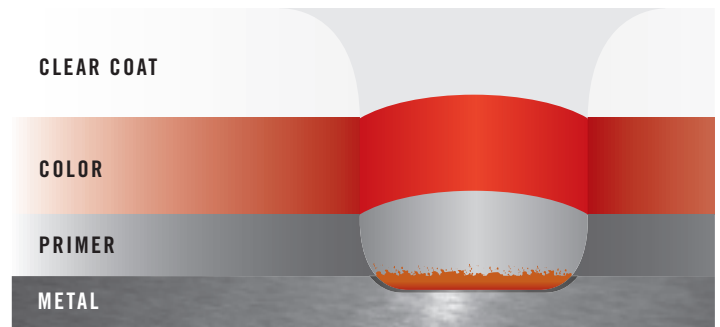


These tools and patience are all that are required

## Tools Required

Remember you are working down at the minute level so glasses, Q tips, micro-sponge applicators, dental tools, 2000 grit sandpaper, polish and microfiber cloth are all required for a good finish. Each trip I take to the

dentist I ask for a couple of broken dental tools. These strong sharp edge instruments are perfect for cleaning out any rust or loose paint that may be in the cavity. The micro- applicators that the dentist uses for applying to your teeth and gums are perfect for applying the paint. They come in different sizes and are a fraction of the cost of the larger applicators offered in the auto or paint market. Get regular and fine. A pack of 100 Microbrush brand will last you a lifetime. 2000 grit sandpaper will be used to sand the area flat. It is as fine as a cotton cloth so don't worry. And a good polish to take out the micro scratches from the sandpaper will bring the shine back to the desired shine. The secret in this entire process is to use micro amounts of paint so you don't create domes above the paint surface. A few mini amounts will stay below the surface and minimize the amount of sanding necessary.



## Small drops only

**Preparation** Firstly you must clean the area with Simple Green or a diluted mineral spirits. Use a Q Tip to clean the area and then dab with clean water.

**Remove rust** Using your dental tool (or a big needle) remove the rust or loose material from the cavity.

**Prime** If you removed rust or see bare metal then a micro drop of primer is required.

**Color** The color paint is applied next but is a super small amount. You do not want to put so much in that you create a dome above the surface. Leave a little room for the clear coat.

**Clear** Apply a small amount of clear and then let it dry overnight. Do all of the chips before sanding.

**Sand** Use lots of spray water as you are sanding with 2000 grit. The surface around the chip area will start showing a dull scratch area but don't panic. When it is perfectly flat you are done.

**Polish** Now use a good polish to work out the scratched area. A small surface you can do by hand or if it is a large area a DA orbital polisher will do the job.

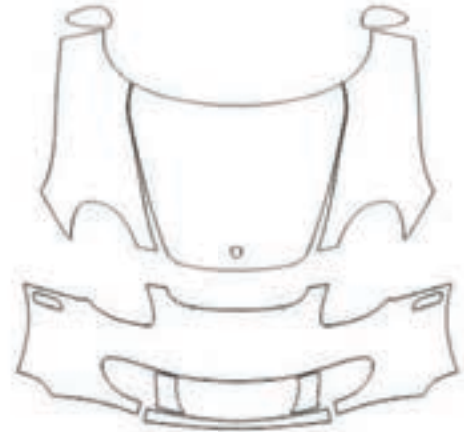
If you are not happy then you can go back and add clear to some of the spots, sand and polish again. There is plenty of paint on Porsches so just be gentle and it will come out like new. But please practice first. If the area shows heavy abrasion, like a front spoiler, then it is better to take it to a professional paint shop. We have several in this area that work on Porsches and can match the color exactly.

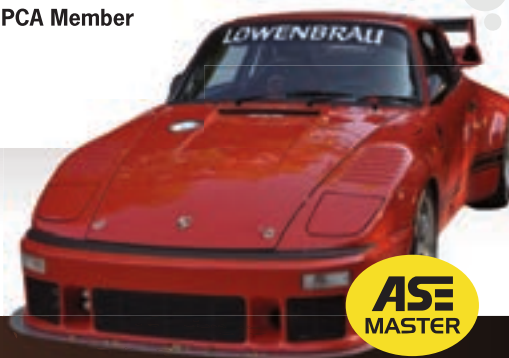

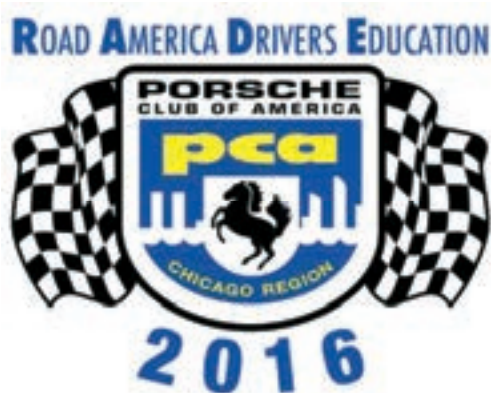

## *R.oad A.merica D.rivers' E.ducation Friday, May 27 – Sunday, May 29*



**The Road America Drivers' Education** "RADE" event is a driver school put on each spring by the Chicago Region Porsche Club with an emphasis on safety. Held in Elkhart Lake, WI at Road America, one of the premier race tracks in the world, this program has been developed over many years to teach you the skills you need to drive your Porsche at its limits in a safe and secure environment.

This event is held over Memorial Day weekend and is open to all Porsche sports cars that can pass technical inspection (Cayennes or Macans are not allowed), and to all drivers age 18 and older with an emphasis on the novice driver. Starting Thursday night, May 26th with a novice driver meeting, and ending Sunday, May 29th, RADE leaves Memorial Day open to celebrate with friends and family.

# 2016 Rallye Season

---

*Tom and Ann Snyder, Rallye Coordinators*

The Chicago Region hosts Time-Speed-Distance rallies. A TSD rallye is one where you match your navigational and driving skills against a Rallye Master who will provide directions and speeds over specified distances. The Rallye Master computes the perfect time and contestants are scored by their measured time against the perfect time.

We have a full season of five rallyes from April to September, preceded by the Rallye School on April 10<sup>th</sup>. At each rallye, awards will be presented to the top six rallye teams, and to the top novice team. In addition, season awards will be presented at the Annual Banquet in December to the top five rallye teams, and to the top Novice Rallye team.

Why rallye? There are lots of reasons but here are our top ten reasons.

1. You start it all when we gather with 20 to 30 Porsche's at a public location, and it's fun to see some of the reactions as folks go by. Or stop to admire your car.
2. The research in advance to find interesting roads to drive is all done in advance and double checked.
3. The speeds to drive and detailed directions to get you out on the route and back are all provided.
4. It is even more interesting for those that are competitively inclined because we measure your times at a number of checkpoints, and tally up the winners closest to the perfect time at the end of the route.
5. The route instructions are prepared in accordance with a standard set of definitions that provide more interest than just following "google" type instructions with mileages spoon fed.
6. If you are a novice, or just intend to enjoy the drive, we can provide simplified "Touring Instructions".
7. It is not necessary to have one of Porsche's sports cars. Cayenne's, Macan's, and Panamera's are welcome.
8. You are not judged on the cleanliness of your car. No need to even dust it off before you come.
9. You get to spend time with like-minded people and enjoy camaraderie with other Porsche rallye teams.
10. There's nothing better than to get out on the open road and drive that beloved Porsche.

The challenge for a rallye team is to interpret the instructions correctly and keep to the designated speed. Rallyes are run on public roads (we will not ask you to exceed the speed limit) so you will have to contend with following directions, stop lights, stop signs, and traffic.

Come to the Rallye School on April 10, 2016 for a chance to learn some of rallye basics. There will be a short beginner's rallye at the end of school to practice what you've learned and a gathering at the end of the rallye at a restaurant to socialize and answer questions.

Still not sure? Don't have a partner? You can contact the Rallye Coordinators and they will try to find another like-minded person to help you form a rallye team. Or volunteer as a Check Point worker – no experience required as on-the-job training is provided the day of the rallye.
