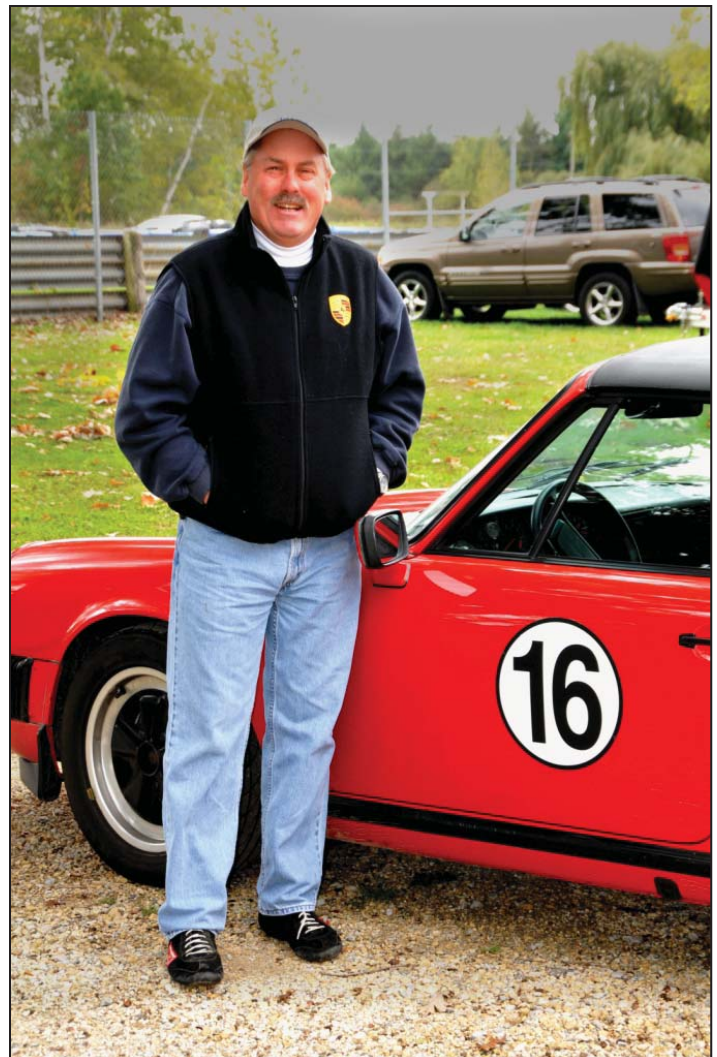

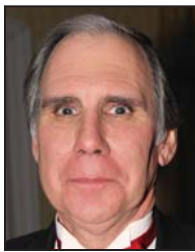

I would like to thank the outgoing Board for all their work and dedication over the past two years. I have been honored to serve with them.

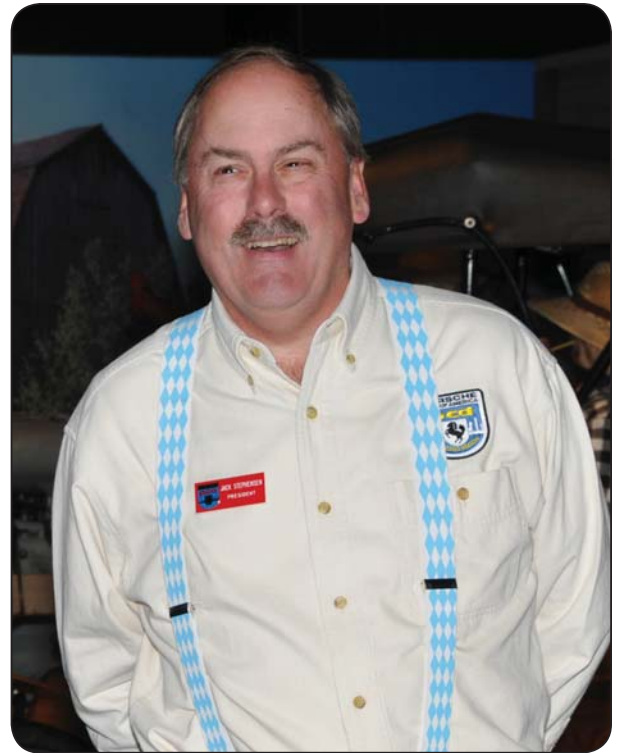

Meeting Called to Order by Jack Stephensen at 8:11 PM, Park Ridge VFW Hall, Park Ridge, IL
Jack Stephensen welcomes the 2009 Board Members, Coordinators, and general membership.

Secretary: Jim Jacisin presented the updated October minutes for approval. Motion to approve Cindy Jacisin; Second Greg Turek; Approved Unanimously

Treasurer: Neil McDonald, as predicted at the start of the 2009 season, he reports that most events this year operated at minimal losses. This year's charity, JDRF continues to show strong numbers with \$8302 added to the initial commitment. Motion to accept Greg Turek; Second John Ruther; Approved Unanimously

Vice President: John Ruther reports that the Annual Membership meeting will be scheduled January 31st at Dave & Busters.
• John questions expected costs, value for the money, venue appropriateness and other options. A short discussion by the Board follows with John asking the Board for a motion to place a

deposit at Dave & Busters for the site of the 2010 General Membership Meeting. Motion Cindy Jacisin; Second Greg Turek; Approved Unanimously

President: Jack Stephensen, with a just completed Octoberfest, Jack expresses his thanks to the entire Blackhawk team.
• Jack asks for nominations to honor those in the Region who deserve recognition at the yearend Holiday dinner dance and awards ceremony.

Autocross: Bob Rath reports that a member asks the Board to consider using 4 out of 5 autocrosses for yearend points due to his scheduling conflict to attend all 5. A short discussion results in year end points being determined by the traditional 5.

Timing & Scoring: George Schaeffer III/Pete Bukantis - Pete reports that the Autocross equipment work as promised by the manufacturer.

Road America: Keith Clark/Chuck LaMantia/Pete Hackenson - Despite the prediction that both RADE and TRAC could operate at a loss this year, Pete reports that he expects both events will break even for the year.
• With the cars exiting the streetside ConcoursDinner Party, Steve Rashbaum expresses concern regarding pedestrian safety. Pete assures the Board that safety measures are in place to keep both participants and spectators safe while exiting back to the track from Elkhart Lake.

Blackhawk Farms: Todd Conforti reports that with 85 drivers, Octoberfest continued a yearlong success for the BlackHawk Drivers Ed program.

GingerMan: Scott Lynn - No report.

Autobahn: Chris Ingot/Dennis Costis - Chris reports that the Regions first visit to Autobahn will be June 14.
• A post-Porsche Parade, Drivers Ed event at AutoBahn Country Club could be offered to attendees in the official registration packet. Chris will evaluate

the level of interest before committing.

Chief Driving Instructor: John Ruther reports on a successful voucher program launched and expresses his thanks to all instructors.

Insurance: Keith Clark - No Report.

Concours: John Diwik - Hank Weil reports that 35 Porsches participated in the Burr Ridge Charity car show, raising additional funds for JDRF.
• Hank also reports a disappointing 6 entrants to the Black Hawk Concours.

Rallye: Ed Barnicle reports that Rallye 5 will feature roads with high CASTs and simple instructions.

Social: Shannon Gallagher reports that the Halloween party is on Oct 31st.
• Cindy Jacisin reports that Toys For Tot's will again be present at the Holiday Dinner Dance.

Membership: Nicki Sangdahl reports membership at 1684, 10 new members in September with 65 renewals and 42 non-renewals.

Safety: Todd Conforti reports that a yearend review illustrates that incidents were down for 2009.

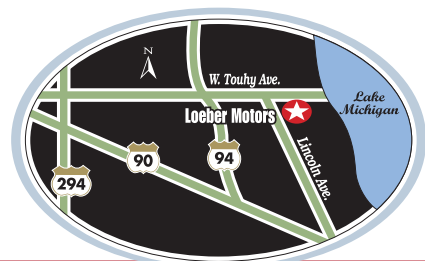

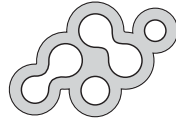
