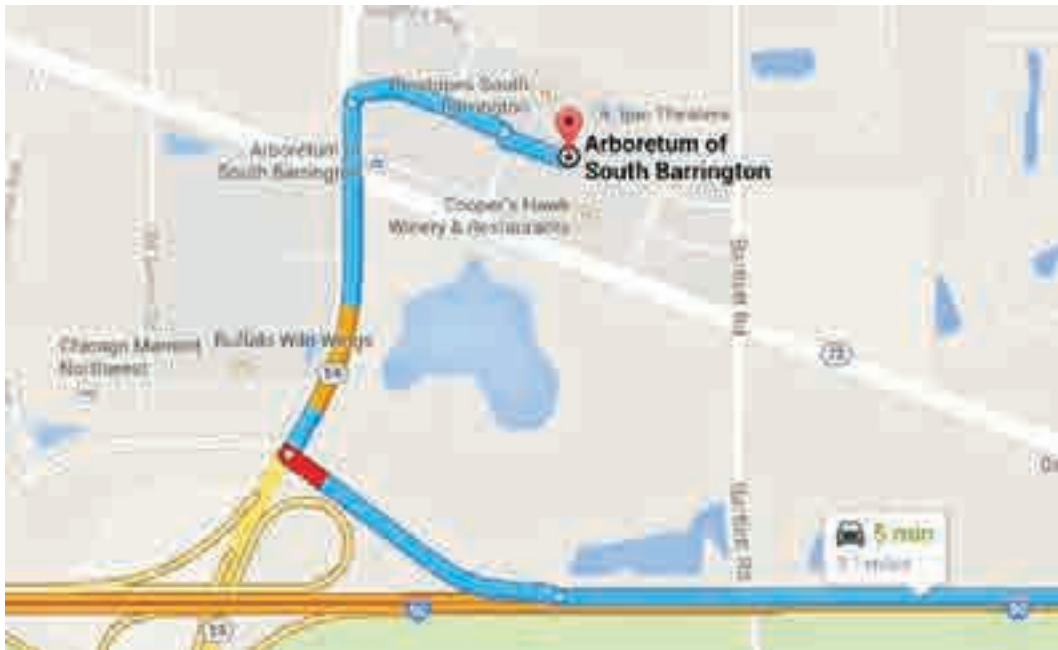

The Chicago Region invites you to join us for our 20th annual Drivers Education weekend at GingerMan Raceway, which is located just outside the scenic Lake Michigan resort community of South Haven, Michigan. This year's event will be held on Saturday, July 25th and Sunday, July 26th and we hope you can join us for one of the season's premier DE events.

GingerMan Raceway is a challenging 2.21 mile road course with 11 turns, a number of elevation changes, and plenty of runoff areas. Not only is it fun to drive, but it was built with optimal driver safety in mind, which makes it a great choice for less experienced drivers.

This is an event to enjoy with your family and friends as the South Haven and nearby Saugatuck resort communities are filled with shopping, restaurants, beaches, family entertainment, and night life. ***As always, if you do plan to join us this year we encourage you to make your lodging reservations as early as possible since many area hotels and resorts sell out months in advance.***

Event registration is open to all PCA members, as well as non-members with track driving experience and an appropriate sports or high performance car that meets the Chicago Region's 2015 DE safety requirements.

Novice drivers are welcome to attend and will be assigned to work with an experienced PCA instructor for the weekend. It is important to note that instructor availability for this event is always limited, therefore novices will be accepted on a first come - first served basis with PCA members given priority over non-PCA members.

We will once again be holding a non-mandatory orientation session on Friday evening, July 24th in the track's pavilion. Although this one hour session is designed for novice and first-time GingerMan drivers, anyone is welcome to attend. It will be hosted by PCA Chicago Region instructors who will review the track layout in detail and present a chalk talk to address the proper driving line, braking points, and other important information related to the weekend's event. An Electric 1967 Porsche 912

When most of us think of "electric" cars or a vehicle that is purpose built to be environmentally friendly, the Porsche brand is probably not top of mind. It's not that Porsche makes cars that pollute any more than others (despite all the recent news in London) it is simply a matter of being better known as makers of the [ultimate, everyday supercar](#); the Porsche 911.

Today's Porsche 911s (997 variants) have their roots in all Porsche models that came before them. One such model is the Porsche 912. Imagine my surprise when surfing around the other day I came across a 1967 Porsche 912 that has been converted to an environmentally friendly, electric Porsche.

Converting a Porsche 912 to an Electric Motor

Based on an article from the German Magazine *Der Spiegel*, it would seem that Jens Broedersdorff and Uwe Koenzen have successfully completed a two-year long conversion of a 1967 Porsche 912 to an all electric version. This ultra quiet, electric version of a classic Porsche has a very limited range of only 90 kilometers (about 55 miles). However, with a top speed of 160 km/h (just under 100 mph) and electric quick acceleration it is certainly a novelty worth mentioning. Jens and Uwe estimate the operational costs to be somewhere around \$2.45 per 55 miles making it very cost effective, just not practical as a long distance commuter. Let's hope they can get some more range out of the car and who knows where they can go from there. Flatsixes.com

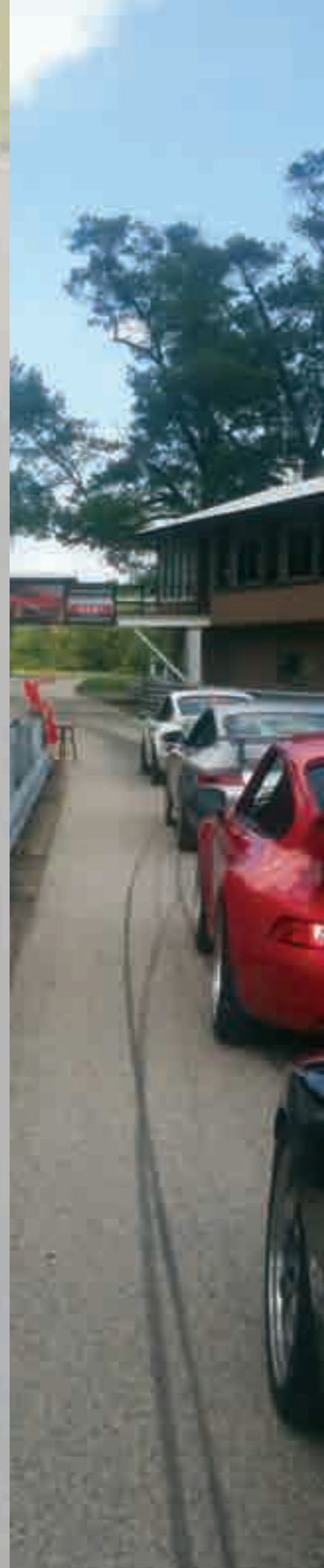

All PCA members interested in acquiring the skills or improving their judging skills for Regional, Zone and National Concours events are invited. 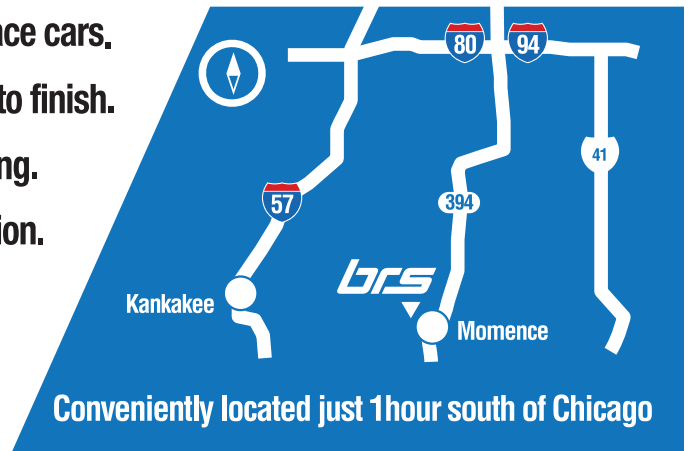
