THE BEST OF THE GOOD GUYS: BRUCE CLAY

It is with great sadness that I share with you the news that Bruce Clay has passed away. As many of you may know, Bruce had been battling lung cancer. Initially the doctors thought they caught it early and had high hopes they could beat it. Recently it returned and the best of medical technology was not enough.

Bruce and Louise joined the X1/9 Club of Chicago at the same time (1980) that Marla and I bought our first sports car (X1/9) and I needed to figure out how to keep it running. That's where we met Bruce and Louise and learned to autocross, sowing the seeds of an addiction that we still enjoy today. Soon our need for speed outgrew our aging Fiats and we both bought Porsches because of the track events being run by PCA Chicago.

Bruce's love affair with cars started way before the X1/9 Club and included a passion for Corvette show cars with correct serial

numbers and all the rest. This later faded (from my point of view, understandably) and he became an accomplished driver who was quick and safe. There was never a second thought about being side-by-side with Bruce as he was always looking out for your safety.

Those who knew Bruce knew him as a generally quiet guy who would always say "yes" when asked to help. Bruce and I chaired numerous autocrosses for the X1/9 Club and the Chicago Region PCA. Bruce and I were the autocross chairmen for several years and you could always count on Bruce to get the job done and more. Bruce didn't seek the spotlight but was very active behind the scenes, making sure that the non-glamorous work that was required for events to run well was done and done very well.

An example is the many hours he spent working with Marla to document and update the autocross

rules that we run by today. Bruce and Louise also chaired a PCA dinner dance a few years ago, but it wouldn't be surprising if you didn't know that. That's just the way he was.

At Bruce's funeral, a close friend he worked with at International Harvester (early in Bruce's career) described guys they worked with who "knew something, had something, knew someone who knew something, or knew where to get a good deal on something" as a "Good Guy" or someone that would help with a question/problem. He described Bruce as "the best of the good guys".

Bruce was a great friend, sought out by many, to spend time with at social and track events. We will miss him a lot.

"Best of the good guys" ... can't be said any better.

PCA Ambassador

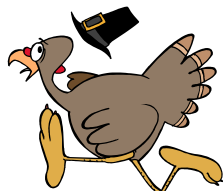
