# Update on 2006 Charity Donation

In 2006, Dogs for the Deaf, Inc. in Central Point, OR, was chosen by the board as a recipient for the PCA Chicago Region charity of the year. Dogs for the Deaf (DFD) rescues dogs, that show promise to be types of service dogs, from shelters and trains them to be Hearing Dogs, Autism Assistance Dogs, Program Assistance Dogs, Career Change Dogs, and dogs as companions for special needs people.

The club contributed money to sponsor a dog for training to be a Hearing Assistance Dog. I'd like to fill everyone in on how our donation was put to use and share some information about our recipient.

Our donation rescued Scooter, a Shih Tzu mix, and paired him with Janice after he was trained as a Hearing Dog. Here is a short summary of their story...

Janice has been deaf for about 20 years and is a chiropractor and consultant. She lost her hearing suddenly due to illness and medications. The world of silence was devastating, and she moved and quit her career. After learning about DFD, she applied for and received her first Hearing Dog, Cajun. With Cajun by her side, Janice returned to her chiropractic practice and to teaching. This twosome was inseparable and a fantastic team for many years until he passed away. Then, Janice returned to the world of silence. After working through the tremendous loss of Cajun, Janice let DFD know she was ready for a new partner.

DFD determined that Scooter was the right dog for her. He is a 2 ½ year beige and black Shih Tzu mix from the Marion County Shelter in OR, and had been a stray. He was perky and confident, in spite of his past. After undergoing the normal medical evaluation and necessary treatments, he was ready to begin training. Obedience training, socialization, and learning to respond to the sounds were part of his everyday schedule. He enjoyed each new challenge and was ready for anything.

Once training was complete, it was time for Scooter and Janice to meet. The trainer and Scooter arrived at Janice's home, and it was hard to tell who was more excited, Janice



or Scooter. They got to know each other and then Scooter began showing Janice what he could do. One day during the placement, they had been very busy and had done a lot of walking. That evening, Scooter alerted Janice and took her to the bedroom. There were no sounds occurring, but he was telling her it was time to go to sleep! At that point, Janice knew that Scooter felt at home and would get her attention and communicate with her.

Scooter now accompanies Janice to work every day and helps her both at work and at home. In May, Janice held an open house at her chiropractic clinic to demonstrate their working relationship to the public. Attendees brought toys to donate to the dogs in training at Dogs for the Deaf—over 65 toys were donated.

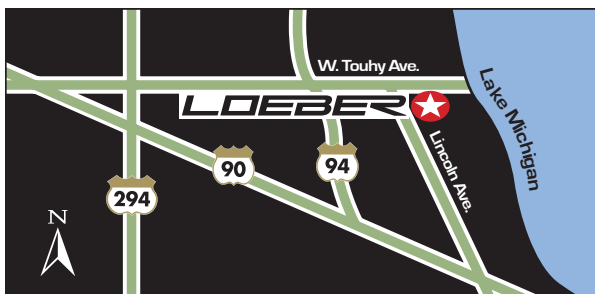
Janice thanks the Chicago Region for their contribution to DFD so she and Scooter could become companions.

# Aungahh!

What is My Carry-on Bag, the Chicago Scene “Identity Crisis and Jack?

Huh? Sorta sounds like the answer to a question on Jeopardy ... close, but no cigar.

Packing for a recent emergency trip, my carry-on bag contained the following items: my laptop, my iPhone, my iPad, and some reading material (a magazine). Was the bag heavy? Yes. Could I have left anything out? No. The first three are each wonderful in their own way but no one device is complete or perfect. It is only the sum of the three that allows me to work (my real job) anywhere and keeps me organized and connected to the rest of my life.

Are there any of us that don't use a computer in both our work and personal arenas? We e-mail, browse, shop, make reservations, read, conference, google, watch movies/ videos/You-Tube, work, Facebook, tweet, blog, populate our calendars, organize our time, and more. We have the ability to find and connect via social media. We skype. We share pictures, tweets, and music effortlessly. I'm no longer amazed when a participant's results are posted on Facebook before the participant leaves the event. ClubRegistration.net is working on a 'live video' link to PCA Club Races. I 'have dinner' with my grandkids in New York once a week via iChat. Even my 89 year old mother has a computer with which she manages almost daily contact with her very widespread family – some of whom were, until recently, living in Budapest. Most work days you will find me with at least two computers and the iPad open. How did we function pre-computer?

Then Steve Jobs gave us the iPhone. (I'm not shilling for

the Apple products. They are just the ones that I have.) Cleaning out a closet recently we found a very old mobile phone – heavy, clunky, and it had an antennae. My new iPhone is none of those things. It slides easily into my pocket and because 'there's an app for that' it allows me to do most of the things that my computers can do. Incredibly, I can remotely connect and work on my desk top computer 'real' time from my phone! Personally I find the screen too small for comfortable reading, working, or gaming and the keypad too small for accurate keyboarding. But if it were not for Messages I would rarely hear from my kids (who have missed the point that its original function was a phone).

Finally, there's my iPad which, if it had a phone feature, would be really close to perfect. I like the screen and keypad size (perfect for Words With Friends) and it, too, because 'there's an app for that' allows me to do most of the things that my iPhone does.

For all of us with not enough time for family, friends, work, 'me' time, partner time, hobbies, working out, etc., we could not be connected to manage our time without these devices.

And, then there was a magazine. Something I threw in the bag to read (when I couldn't be connected) that I had thumbed thru quickly when it arrived but saved to read in depth when I had time.

So what does this have to do with the Chicago Scene Identity Crisis?

First, a short history of the Chicago Scene. Many years ago some people with Porsches were drawn together by their love of the marque. Soon they began to get together on a semi-regular basis. News of those gatherings first traveled via telephone trees and later via a printed publication – the Chicago Scene. For many years the Chicago Scene was the source of all the news concerning the Chicago Region. It flourished under the stewardship of many dedicated editors (most of whom did it without computers and publishing software). After some time the Region decided to add a web site. It too grew under the stewardship of several webmasters. And, now, we have added the various e-mail blasts to our arsenal of information dispersal. Three different, but sometimes redundant, suppliers of information to our members.

The Chicago Scene Identity Crisis came to a head about 18 months ago, stemming primarily from the inability to balance where the Scene fit in the information dispersal program against the increasing time and costs related to producing an issue against the membership desire for both a web and printed issue. Added to this was the need to keep the size of each issue to 44 – 48 pages and balance the number of pages that were ads, Event Announcements, required articles, with articles of interest – at the height of our season some issues were mostly ads and Event Announcements with not much room for any articles of interest.

The logistics required that an issue, when completed, be posted on the website and sent to the printer at the same time. While the posted issue was current, in the time it took to print and mail it, the printed issue was often ‘out of date’ when members received it. Money not well spent. We went to two issues each month – one for the website that included all event announcements and another for print that included only those announcements relevant after the issue was received. More time spent producing the issues but some money saved. Alas, the relevance was not solved due to the variance of postal delivery schedules – I usually receive my Scene within 5 days of mailing, others not for 3 weeks.) We tried issues every other month – same problems. While never in competition with either the website or the e-mail blasts, it became increasingly difficult to determine the role of the Chicago Scene and where and how it fit. Conversations with John Ruther, Jack Stephensen, Board Members, other editors, others involved with print media, and almost anyone who would listen resulted in some acceptable ideas, none seemed a good answer for our Region.

It was during the struggle to get this issue out that I realized that the situation was like the contents of my carry-on bag ... the website, the Scene, and the e-mail blasts are each wonderful resources in their own way - none is the complete or perfect answer. That realization, combined with Jack’s suggestion to consider what each does best and only utilize those features (spread the load) gave the Chicago Scene back its identity and defined for me its place.

The website perfectly fulfills our need for instant, ‘real’ time information --- the Region Event Calendar, a monthly President’s Letter, Event Announcements, Forms, pictures, back issues of the Scene, Venue Rules and Notes, etc. It’s in color, and instantly accessible via any connection device. Your device calendar can be synced with the schedule on-line and you’ll always be up-to-date on events – even ones added within a week or so of their date.

The e-mail blasts are terrific reminders of impending events – just like the ‘reminder’ features on our devices ... they give you the link to the event which can then be saved to your device. In the case of Event changes they can be used to get the ‘word out’ fast. For Rallies they provide the Supplemental Instructions upfront of the event itself.

And the Chicago Scene? The magazine in my carry-on bag

was not the Scene ... but it was something that I wanted to read in depth when I had time. Such is the content of the Chicago Scene: Membership News, Anniversaries, Board Minutes, detailed articles with event follow-up and/or results, pictures, articles of interest by various authors on various subjects. The size of the Scene as well as the length and complexity of the articles and pictures are possibly too long to read on a device or are best enjoyed at leisure (not standing in line at the Post Office). Most of the content is not duplicated on the website or in an e-mail blast. Additionally, it addresses the desire of our members to see their names and their cars in print. Rare is the member who, when they make the cover, does not request extra copies for family and scrapbooks.

Bottom line, all three resources, each properly configured, used together will best and most completely serve our Region members.

Going forward, here’s the plan for the Chicago Scene – I’m sure there’ll be some tweaking.

The Scene content will be all of the items noted above as well as a President’s Letter, additional items of member interest and, hopefully, columns from each of the venue coordinators. By removing the ‘time-sensitive’ items the Scene will have a predictable schedule - helpful for our members, the Leeds, the Post Office, our advertisers, and Ed Soske at Press Tech (our printer) who will no longer be subjected to my pathetic pleading to get the issue ASAP because I waited for one last late Announcement.

This issue, which includes coverage of some events in June and July, is Volume 11.5. The Mart is up to date through November 1st. There will be 1 more issue in 2011 - on-line late November.

The Scene will not contain the Region Event Calendar, Event Forms and Event Announcements. The website Calendar is always up to date. By pushing the Forms and Announcements to the website they can be expanded to include more details and perhaps directions. In turn, the size (and therefore the printing/ mailing costs) of the Scene will be reduced. (In a recent issue Forms and Announcements accounted for 16 pages.) And, because the e-mail blasts will keep you abreast of changes and imminent events, you will no longer have the excuse that you didn’t know about an event.

So, yes, it is an answer – a good answer for the Chicago Region.
