A TECHNICAL VIEWPOINT

Porsche Foot Well Lights

When was the last time your keys or toll change fell on the floor of the car at night? Did you curse out the Porsche factory for not adding floor lighting? Well, don't fret any more, there is an easy way to add that additional (required?) feature. These lights can be added to any Porsches for about \$15 and your time.

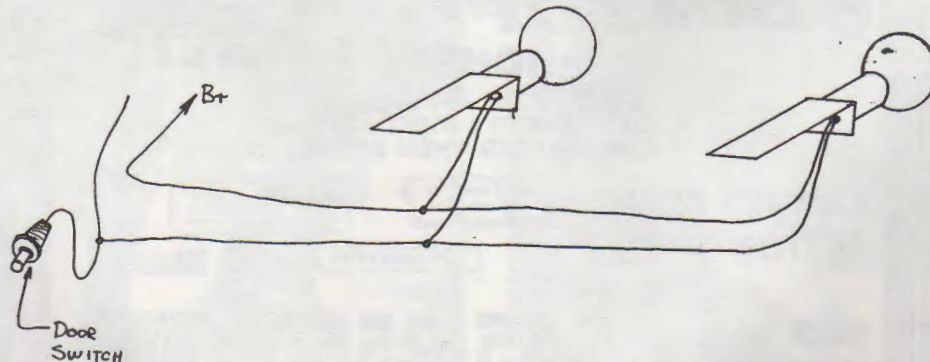
All Porsches use a switch mounted near the door hinges to turn on the interior lights. We will use this switch to turn our new lights on when the doors open. The first thing we need to do is find the switch on the drivers side, and locate a brown or brown and white wire connected to it. The wire usually is located behind the carpeting near the hood release on 924, 944, and 928's. In 911's the wire has black tubing on it but it is still in the same place. Once you find the wire, the project is about half over. Now let's find a good place for hooking the lights to a source of battery voltage or "B+". If you have a Haynes or the factory manuals, this is an easy task. If you don't, the Haynes or Clymer manuals are only about \$12 and worth every penny. Find the schematics for your car year and find either the lighting or interior light diagrams. The B+ we need can then be tapped off the fuse for those lights.

Once all the wiring points are found, we need the following parts:

2 GE-90 light bulbs	Trak Auto
2 Sockets for above	Trak Auto
Screws to secure sockets	Hardware store
Misc. wire	Radio Shack
Shrink tubing	Radio Shack
Tie wraps	Radio Shack

1. Once all the parts are purchased, determine where you want to mount the lights. In my 911 I screwed them down to the sheet metal underneath the dash near the sides of the car.

2. Hook up the lights as shown in the diagram below and install.



3. Cut the door switch wire and slip a piece of shrink tubing on one of the wires. Twist one of the light wires together with the door switch wires and solder. Slip the heat shrink tubing over the connection and heat it with a match or hair dryer to shrink.

4. Run the other wire to the B+ in your fuse block and secure.

5. Tie wrap loose wires and check how the lights work.

Now that the lights are in and, you are proud of yourself, try them out. At midnight get in your car, drop your keys, open the door, and guess what ...visible keys!

TECH TIP OF THE MONTH

If your 911 CIS equipped car has a pop off valve, check it monthly to see if it is still secure and the air filter doesn't have any burnt holes in it. Sometimes the epoxy supplied with the kits doesn't hold and the valve pops out and the car won't start. Also, when the valve pops, the air filter can get burned which creates nasty holes.

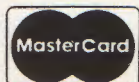
