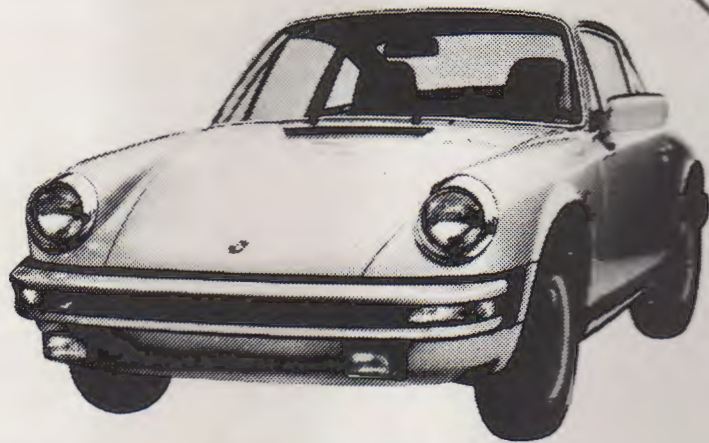

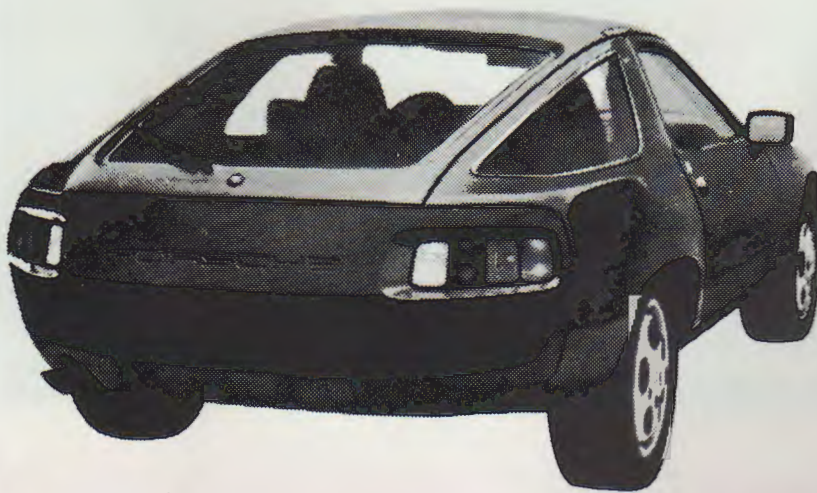

I announced to the Board the results of the recent election of Officers. A total of 152 ballots were received.

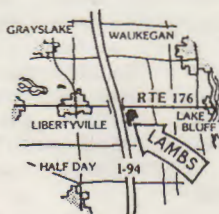

It is a real adventure and quite a challenge. Just ask anyone who has attended in the past.
