The other half of the Chasseur team is Karel Hula, who has been in the restaurant business all but the first five years of his life. Wine is his passion and it finds its expression in the wine list which consists of over 135 selections. Karel guarentees that you will not leave thirsty.

If the weather is cooperative, bring your Porsche, there will be an informal concours where Tamara and Karel will pick their favorite cars. The owners will receive a complimentary bottle of wine.

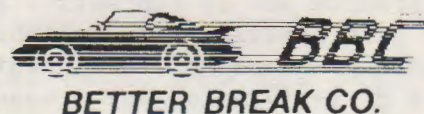

We're still looking for a new editor. It would be a good idea to get your feet wet now. Don't be shy, Howard's waiting to hear from you. Your club needs you.

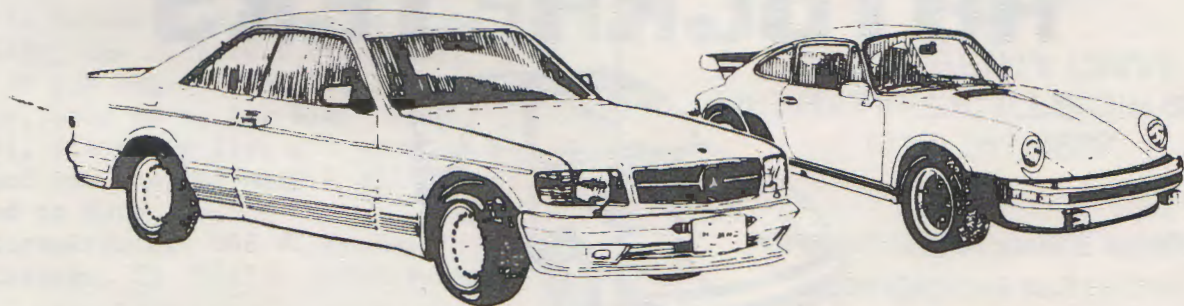
