## Palm Springs Parade

Another memorable PCA Parade is in the history books. While this was only my third Parade, it was one where I felt more involved than the others. Even though we didn't have our Porsche with us in Palm Springs, there were still plenty of activities, with multiple Tours leaving for various destinations every day. And with the unrelenting heat in the Coachella Valley, a drive in the mountains provided welcome relief, along with some fantastic driving roads. The routes and destinations were well thought out and enjoyed by everyone.

One of the main attractions of any Parade is the Concours, and this one was no exception. Given the water restrictions in the region, event competitors had a more difficult task than at previous Parades, but at least there was never a worry about rain! The setting for the Concours was like a postcard, too, with 100+ cars parked on the green, treeless golf course. In addition, a large pond provided a calming foreground while the rugged San Jacinto and Santa Rosa Mountains formed a fearsome backdrop. We made sure to arrive early on event judging days to avoid the heat and were treated to a glass-smooth water surface which created a mirrored reflection of this idyllic scene.

Naturally, there were unforeseen occurrences. On our first Tour, for example, we were only 30 minutes into the drive when disaster struck in the form of a flat tire. We motioned the chase car that we would be fine and that they should stay with the group. After a failed attempt to use the fix-a-flat kit that came with our rental Shelby GT, we called Hertz, and within 30 minutes Julieanne was there with her flatbed to haul us and our car back to Palm Springs. Along the way we had a very lively conversation with her, learning almost enough about her life to author a biography.

Because we were Porscheless, we couldn't compete in one of our favorite events, which is the TSD Rallye (please also note the Chicago Region spelling here). However, we were allowed to compete in the Gimmick Rallye, which proved to be as much fun as it was challenging. The task was to keep track of the speed limit signs as you drove a route that took you up into the mountains and back down again. The specified speed was counted as a positive or negative number depending on what type of sign it was. Teams had to keep a running tally and provide a numerical answer at the end of the Rallye. The beautiful mountain scenery only added to the difficulty in concentrating on this mathematical task.

Volunteering is a big part of any Parade and while my wife Dominique assisted at the art show, I went to the Autocross to chase cones. Naturally, the course was one of the more difficult ones that I've seen, seemingly using virtually every traffic cone available in southern California. Yes, plenty of competitors got lost at first, but with additional runs they all eventually learned their way around the circuitous course.

In sum, attending a Porsche Parade should be on every PCA member's to-do list. Everyone you'll meet has the same passion for the marque as you do, and learning how the other Regions operate will give you a unique perspective on what we do and how we do it in the Chicago Region.

# Porsche Parade Concours, 2023

The 2023 Porsche Parade was held June 18th-24th in historic and picturesque Palm Springs, CA at the La Quinta Resort, with the Concours held at the PGA West Pete Dye Mountain Course. Over 1,000 entrants experienced the full Porsche experience during the week long annual gathering. The Parade Team of volunteers from across the country led by the Chicago Region's Jack Stephensen (Parade Chair), planned and executed an outstanding experience for all attendees.

The premier Parade event is the Concours d'Elegance and the 2023 Co-Chairs were Chicago Region members Pat Yanahan and myself; I also served as the event's Head Judge. This year over 100 Porsches from around the country competed in this not to be missed presentation of spectacularly prepared cars. A full range of models and years, from the earliest and rarest to the most recent were on display. Competitors began arriving as early as the prior Thursday to begin their final preparations. Cars were grouped for judging based on specific criteria into either Restoration, Preservation, Preparation 1 or Preparation 2 and then further divided into "Classes" based on the model of Porsche. Entrants in the Concours compete against other cars of the same model for class awards. They are judged by nationally recognized judges using a scoring system in which perfection is the objective. Differences between first and second places are often only a 0.1 point.

This year over 80 judges participated in the selection of which cars would be crowned the Best of the Best in the four groupings. The Chicago Region was represented in the Judges' ranks by James Dorfman, Candyce Jones, Steve Kuk, Rich LaMarre, and John Moore. In addition, Chicago Region members Nancy Grove, Suzanne LaMarre and Barb Mashburn supported the Concours Scoring Chair, Jana

Cornell and related processes led by Linda Gordon. Likewise, a special thank you must go out to John and Matthew Moore, James Dorfman, and Rich LaMarre for their multi-day efforts outdoors executing the Concours field layout. I would also be remiss without thanking the 100+ volunteers who supported the Concours prep area, staging, traffic control, scoring, awards presentation, pre- and post-event planning, and banquet as it truly takes a large team to deliver an event of this caliber.

# Chicago Region Bylaws have been Revised – TIME TO VOTE

In 2022, the board directed a committee to update our Bylaws to incorporate the following items:

- Remote Board Meetings
- eMail and/or other types of distributed motions
- An explicit procedure for replacing a director that is elected as an officer before the end of the director's term
- The ability to have electronic voting

During that process, the committee learned that all changes to bylaws must be reviewed and approved by the Porsche Club of America National Policy Committee. The Policy Committee's review is not restricted to the changes and includes a review of the entire document. The Policy Committee provides guidelines on what it expects to be included in a region's bylaws and provides sample text as a guideline. This resulted in a number of changes beyond our original intentions. The purpose of the national guidelines is to ensure that a region's governance is performed in the best interest of its members and all regions are managed in substantially the same way.

The revised Bylaws have been reviewed and approved by the Chicago Region's Board and subsequently reviewed approved by the PCA National Policy Committee.

It is now time for you, our members, to review the changes and vote.
