General Information

All students, family members, volunteers, and guests must sign in with Autobahn Country Club (ABCC). Registration will occur at the Registration Building; the 1st building on right when you enter ABCC. Registration opens at 7AM.

Participants and their parents must sign the PCA waiver and bring it to the event. If the student is under 18 years of age, the waiver must be signed by the student's parent(s) or guardian(s) in front of PCA registration personnel. If a parent or guardian is not attending the event, the absent parent/guardian's signature must be notarized.

Instructors, Students, and Guest/Family Members will be given Wristbands. There may be new or additional information for that day's requirements distributed prior to the event. Please read all emails you receive from the event registrar.

Only students and instructors, with appropriately colored wristbands, will be allowed to drive in the exercise areas during this event. Exercise area personnel will check wristbands. There must be a registered PCA Instructor with appropriate wristband in the car at all times in the exercise area.

All students must present a valid driver license at registration. Traffic violation slip in lieu of driver's license is not acceptable. You will not be able to participate in the event without a valid license. When driving through the paddock, please note there is a **15 MPH maximum** speed limit in the paddock area.

Parents are encouraged to come to all the classroom sessions and watch the driving exercises. They will not be allowed in the cars with the students while the school is going on. Depending on the time schedule the student might have an opportunity to drive their parents around on the course at the end of the day.

Safety

Safety is the Chicago Region's main priority and we want you to feel as strongly about safety as we do. We expect you to do everything in your power to make this event safe for yourself, your fellow students, the organization, volunteers and the ABCC personnel.

No EV (Electric Vehicles) or Open-Wheeled vehicles are allowed.

Participants and their guests cannot consume any alcohol or controlled substances during the hours of the events' operation, nor may any person in the paddock area. This is not intended to prevent participants from taking medication for which they have a valid prescription, if such medications do not carry a warning that usage may have an effect upon the person's ability to control a vehicle.

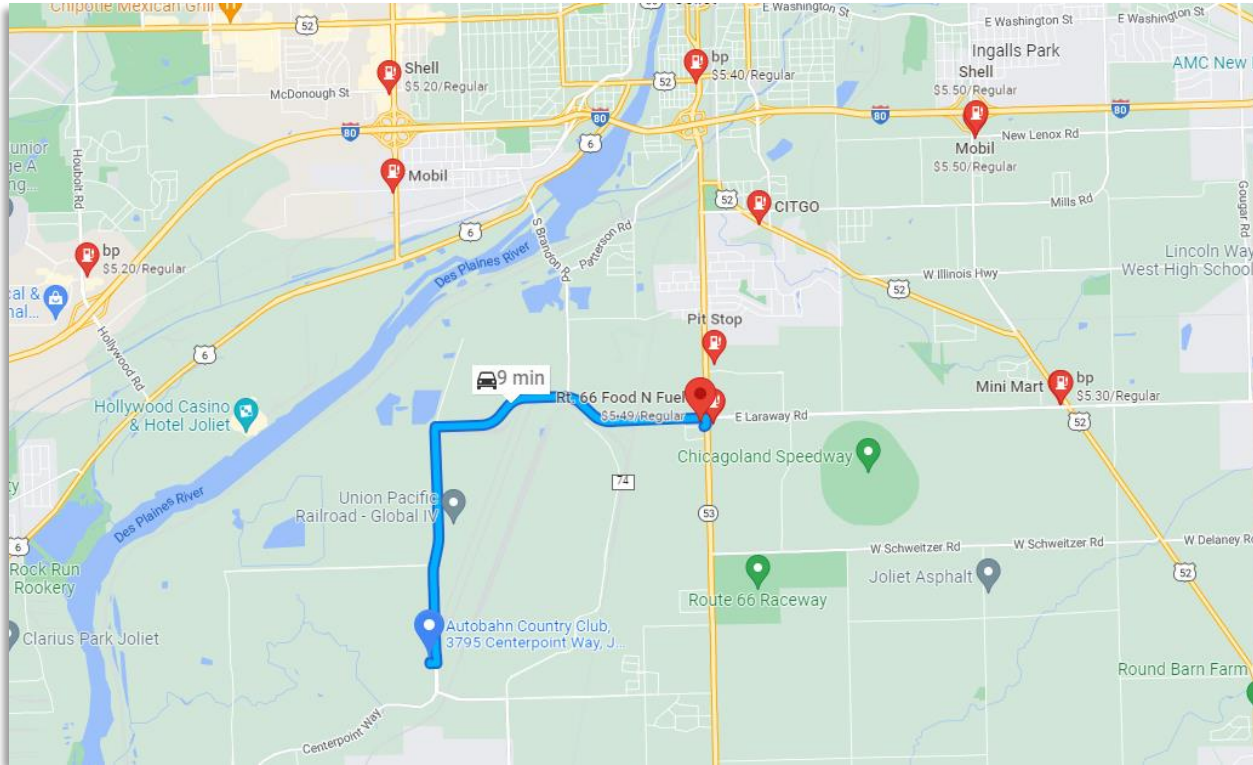
Come to the Event Prepared

To ensure you make the most of your time at the event, come prepared. Here are some suggestions.

- Student and/or student's family member, should bring the completed waiver forms with you and have them ready to present to the registration personnel. If the student is under 18 years of age, the waiver must be signed by the student's parent(s) or guardian(s) in front of PCA registration personnel. If a parent or guardian is not attending the event, the absent parent/guardian's signature must be notarized.
- Bring your Driver's License, Credit Card, Cash.
- Fill your tank before you get to the track. There is gas at the track, but it is much more expensive than at local gas stations.
- Please empty your vehicles' center console, door pockets, glove box and trunk of all loose contents. Please try and do this before you come to the school it will save you time and possibly some embarrassment. Secured spare tires are fine. Be sure to check under the seats also. It is a good idea to bring a tarp or plastic bags to protect your belongings from the elements.
- You should consider bringing a small cooler containing drinks and snacks. Lunch will be provided, and there will be water available, however, some people may find they need additional sustenance during the day.
- Sunscreen.
- You should wear long pants, a long-sleeved shirt, and closed-toed shoes such as sneakers when driving.
- These events are rain (snow) or shine, so bring appropriate cover if inclement weather is expected.

Closest Gas Stations

Gasoline is available at Autobahn, but it is much more expensive than what is available at nearby stations. Here are the gas stations located on the way to the track. We suggest you arrive with a full tank of gas.



Check-in and Registration

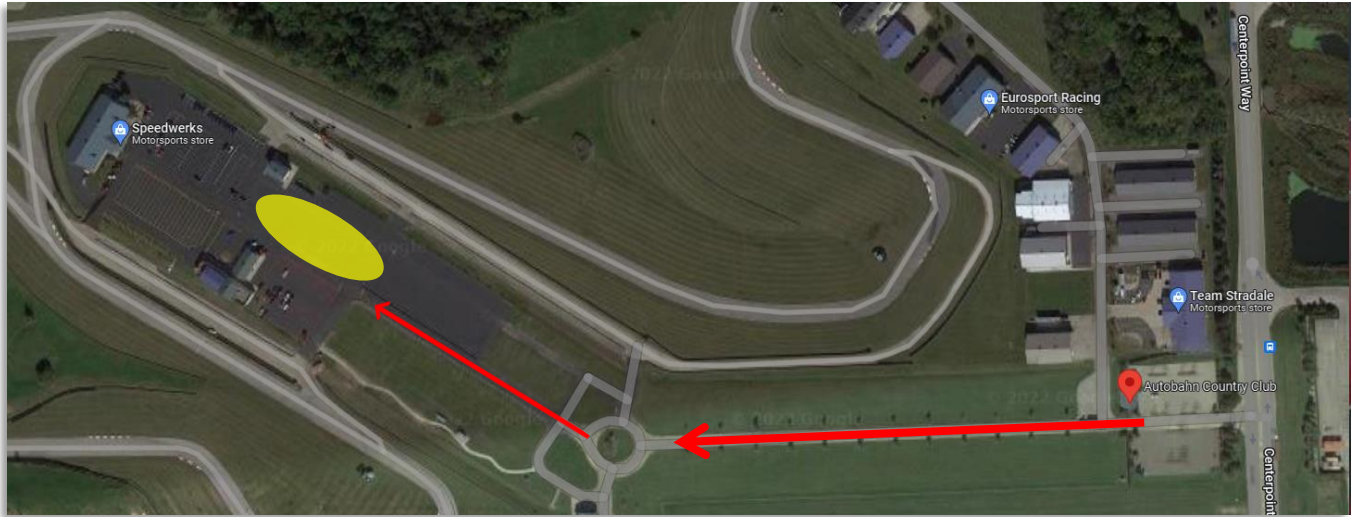


- Park in the lot to the right as you enter the facility.
- Line up while waiting your turn.
- Complete the PCA waivers prior to arrival. Remember, if your teen is under 18 and both parents are not able to attend, the waiver form must have the missing parent's signature notarized.



- You will be required to sign the Autobahn Event Waiver as part of registration.
- All students must present a valid driver's license at registration.
- You will receive a color-coded wristband that must be worn at all times. This indicates your role.

The Paddock



- Speed limit is **15 MPH maximum**
- Find a place to park in the area labeled on the map.
- Maintain 10 feet between cars.

Going Through Tech

Once you have found a parking space in the paddock you should prepare to bring your car through tech inspection.



- Empty your car and place your stuff in front of your car or in your trunk before going to tech. **ALL LOOSE ITEMS must be removed.**
- Windows must be down.
- Line up on the appropriate side based on signage.
- Answer the tech inspector's questions and do whatever they tell you to do.
- You will be introduced to your coach here as well.
- Return to your parking space when complete.

Classroom / Restrooms

The classroom and restrooms for this school is held in the south building adjacent to the Tech building. The entrance is on the north side of the building. The restrooms are to the right and the classroom is to the left.
